

# View Caps Water Supply Corporation

The VIEW-CAPS WSC water system PWS ID 2210004 has violated the monitoring/reporting requirement: set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

This violation occurred in the monitoring period 1 January 2017 thru March 31 2017

We are taking the following actions to address this issue: View Caps WSC submitted their report on 4/10/2017 electronically thru the STEERS program to the State but cannot prove it. Therefore, we will no longer solely rely on the electronic submission form, but will also mail a copy of this form to the State. Hopefully this will stop this problem from occurring again. View Caps does test the water on a daily basis at several locations in our system.
